

Management of Trails on Town Land

The Lee Trails Committee, a subcommittee of the LCC, was started in 2021 and charged by the Conservation Commission to manage the town trail system to current national standards, improve trail safety and increase trail access to all community members.

The three main trail systems in Lee are located in the Town Forest, Little River Park, and the Maud Jones Memorial Forest. All trails are family friendly and are used by a large number of town residents as well as people from nearby communities.

Since its formation, the Trails Committee and community volunteers have accomplished much at the three established trail areas: re-blazed trails; trimmed brush; removed unsafe trees and branches; rerouted muddy, flooded and dangerous trails; fixed and/or replaced footbridges; and developed erosion control measures. The Committee's goal is to continue to improve safety, access, and enjoyment for all community members.
