# STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE.

At a legal Town Meeting, duly notified and holden at *Lee*, in the county of *Strafford*, on the second Tuesday of March, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty-two, the following votes of the inhabitants of said town, present and qualified to vote for Senators, were given in for **Councillor**, and were received in presence of the Selectmen of said town, in open town meeting, by the Moderator thereof, who, in said meeting, in presence of the said Selectmen and the Clerk of said town, sorted and counted said votes, and at the close of the poll made a public declaration thereof, with the name of every person voted for, and the number of votes for each person, as follows:

For *John L. Purley* 45 votes,
