Time: Registration begins at 9:30 a.m. Entries must be registered by 11 am. Judging at noon.

Place: Lee Library Lawn

Categories:

- One crust fruit/berry pie (Sorry, no custard, squash, pumpkin, etc.)
- Two crust fruit/berry pie
- Sweet Breads
- Relishes
- Pickles: Sweet
- Pickles: Dill
- Pickles: Sour
- Pickles: Other

The Rules:

- All fruits, berries, veggies, & herbs (except exotic spices like cinnamon, nutmeg & cloves) used in your recipes must be grown and harvested in Lee.
- Flour does not have to be locally produced. However, all pie crust and other dough must be fully made from scratch using only natural ingredients.
- All entries must be registered no later than 11:00 a.m. on Fair Day.
- Each participant will sign in and be given an entry number. Their entries will be labeled with corresponding numbers.
- Entries may not contain any labeling of any kind other than the Category and Entry number.
- All entries must include an ingredients list, but not the recipe, taped to the bottom of the entry.

Judging:

Judges will be selected from the various town boards, committees, commissions and departments.

Judging will be based on

- Presentation
- Originality
- Texture
- Aroma
- Flavor

Winners will be announced at 1:00 pm or at the conclusion of judging, on stage at the grange.

Entries may be retrieved upon conclusion of judging. Any entries remaining after completion of the judging will be disposed of (which probably means eaten!)

Prizes: Will be awarded for each category and for Best of Show!
