

LEE OLD HOME DAY HARVEST SUPPER 2011 DESSERT CONTEST

Rules

1. **Contestants should pre-register by emailing or calling Annie Gasowski @ 659-5273 or anniegasowski@gmail.com.** Contestants must complete form and be entered in the name of the person who made the dessert. Entries will be assigned a number and judging will take place before the entrant's names are identified. Entries may not contain any labeling of any kind other than the Category and Entry number. One entry per person per category.
2. All desserts must be made from scratch and all natural ingredients should be used in the recipe (no mixes or prepared ingredients such as Jello, Cool Whip, etc.). Ingredients must be listed on a 3X5 card to provide information for people with food allergies.
3. Categories:
 - a. Cakes
 - b. Pies
 - c. Cookies/ Bar Cookies/ Brownies
 - d. Other Desserts (puddings, custards, cobblers, crisps, crumbles, etc)
4. Desserts must be registered at the dessert tent before 4:00 PM. Please provide at least one full size recipe and serving utensils. After judging, all desserts will be available to dinner ticket holders. If refrigeration is needed please provide cooler.

Judging

1. Judging will start at about 4:45 PM.
2. Minimum of three judges.
3. Entries will be assigned a number and judging will take place before the entrant's names are identified.
4. Criteria for judging –

	Point total 100
• Overall Appearance/Presentation	Up to 25 Points
• Flavor (aroma, taste, balance of flavoring)	Up to 35 Points
• Texture/Consistency (evenly baked, doneness)	Up to 15 Points
• Moistness/Crumb (as applicable to category)	Up to 15 Points
• Creativity/Originality	Up to 10 Points

Scoring

Each judge assigns a numerical value for each category without consultation with the other judges. The dessert receiving the highest total numerical value is the winner in that category. In case of a tie judges will judge those desserts again. Each category will include first, second and third place awards. Winners will be announced at the end of dinner and completion of Peoples Choice voting.

People's Choice Award

Dinner ticket holders may sample desserts and vote on their ticket for their two favorite desserts.

The entry with the highest number of votes will take first place and second highest will take second place.

Prizes: \$20 for first place in each category; \$50 for first place People's Choice
