

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Renewals – You may present your registration, renewal notice or your driver's license to renew your motor vehicle registration. If no changes to the registration are required, you may renew online at www.leenh.org.

Transfers – To get credit for time remaining on your old registration you must have your original current registration or a certified copy which can be obtained for a fee of \$15 at the DMV or \$17.50 at the Town Clerk's office.

New – 2000 model years and up must be titled. If purchased from a NH dealer, you must present the Application for Certificate of Title (blue paper). If purchased out of state or a private sale, you must present the certificate of origin or the title signed over to you. The new owner will need to sign the application for the new Title.

Years prior to 2000 – you will need one of the following:

- A copy of a New Hampshire registration from a former owner
- A Title
- Verification of VIN form (TDMV19A), available at Town Clerk's office or State of NH website. The TDMV19A must be filled out by a NH Law Enforcement Officer, NH Inspection Station, or a NH Dealer.

If you are moving to New Hampshire from another state, you will need the following:

- Current driver's license
- Proof of Residency
- Title for your vehicle (If you have an out of state lien holder, you will need to present your current registration and the name and address of your lien holder.)

Plate Types –

Passenger Plate: These are the standard issue plates with the “old man of the mountain” design.

Decal Plate: These plates allow for a 3”x 3” authorized decal to be placed on the plate. The legislature approves which organizations can sell decals to be placed on these plates. They cost an additional \$15.

Vanity Plate: These are the personalized plates that can be obtained for an additional \$40 for a twelve month period. Vanity Plates are now processed at the town clerk's office. Applications for vanity plates can be found at the NH DMV website or at the town clerk's office.

Veteran Plate: Veterans who wish to apply for this plate will need to bring their DD214 to the DMV and apply there.

Conservation (Moose Plate): These plates benefit NH conservation efforts and cost an additional \$30 per year. Also available in vanity plates.

State Park Plate: This plate allows admission into most NH state parks. The cost is an additional \$85 per year. Also available in vanity plates.

Conservation Parks Plate: This is a combination of the state parks plate and the conservation (moose) plate. Cost is an additional \$85 per year for the state parks plate and an additional \$30 for conservation. Also available in vanity plates.
