Treasurer's Report: As of March 30, there is \$11,973.99 in the Operations Account, \$919.64 in the non-lapsing account and \$6202.97 in the CD.

Facilities Committee update: A new Town Hall could possibly be built at Stevens Field; the library needs to begin developing a plan for expanding at its current site. It was suggested that knitting group be involved in the selection of new chairs. It's possible that the library could get some leather chairs from the Hampton Library.

There will be a meeting to discuss the possibility of a printed Lee newsletter on Wed, April 26 at 7 pm at the Safety Complex; the trustees agreed to send a representative.

The Lee Library birthday party will be held Friday, April 21, from 3-5 pm.

As part of their Service program, OR Middle School students will work on the flower beds on May 11.

The trustees will discuss revisions to the Employee Handbook at the next meeting.
