

## ORDINANCE – TOWN OF LEE

### MISUSE OF POWER

#### **Authority**

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Chapter 31, Section 39, and 41:11 New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, (RSA 31:39 and 41:11), the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Lee adopt the following ordinances:

#### **Purpose**

No Person shall operate any motor vehicle within the Town of Lee so as to make excessive noise by any of the following means:

1. Misuse of power, acceleration or traction so as to spin the wheels, in the manner commonly known as “**Laying Rubber**”.
2. Misuse of brake and stopping power in the deceleration of a motor vehicle where no emergency exists.
3. Misuse of power, acceleration or traction by means of rapid up shift of gears.
4. Misuse of stopping or deceleration by means of rapid downshift of transmission gears.
5. Racing of engine by means of the accelerator, carburetor, gear selector, either when the motor vehicle is in motion or stationary.

#### **Penalty**

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense and not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each violation thereafter within one year.
