

ORDINANCE – TOWN OF LEE

ALCOHOL REGULATIONS

Authority

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Chapter 41, Section 11, New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, (RSA 41:11), the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Lee adopt the following ordinances:

Definitions

Public Place: means any place to which the public or a substantial group has access. The term includes, but is not limited to, public ways as defined by New Hampshire revised Statutes Annotated 259:125, sidewalks, public areas, schools, municipal and government buildings or facilities, the lobbies of apartment buildings, the lobbies and hallways of buildings where business establishments are located, and businesses establishments during time periods when the general public has access, except businesses properly licensed by the New Hampshire Liquor Commission to sell alcohol or liquor for consumption “ON THE PREMISES”. “Public Place” to include, but not limited to, the Lee USA Speedway parking lots, Durgin Preserve, or any other Town Owned or maintained properties.

Purpose

It shall be unlawful for any person to consume or possess in an open can, bottle, or other container, any alcoholic beverage or liquor, as defined by Chapter 175 of the New Hampshire Revised Statues Annotated, while in a motor vehicle or standing in, or upon, a public place.

Penalty

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each violation.
