To see if the Town will vote to establish a contingency fund for Fiscal Year 2023 for unanticipated expenses that may arise and further to raise and appropriate Twenty Thousand dollars (\$20,000) to go into the fund. This sum to come from the Unassigned Fund Balance and no amount to be raised from general taxation. Any appropriation left in the fund at the end of the year will lapse to the general fund. The governing body shall annually publish a detailed report of all expenditures from the fund. The Select Board recommends this article. Majority vote required.	YES C
ARTICLE 12 To see if the town will vote to change the purpose of the existing Fire Pond and Cistern Capital Reserve Fund to allow for the installation of new fire ponds and cisterns and to allow for repair and replacement of existing fire ponds and cisterns and to name the select board as agents to expend. The Select Board recommends this article. 2/3 vote required.	YES C
Shall the town modify the provisions of RSA 72:39-a for elderly exemption from property tax in the Town of Lee, based on assessed value, for qualified taxpayers, to be as follows: for a person 65 years of age up to 74 years, \$217,500; for a person 75 years of age up to 79 years, \$262,500; for a person 80 years of age or older, \$337,500. To qualify, the person must have been a New Hampshire resident for at least 3 consecutive years, own the real estate individually or jointly, or if the real estate is owned by such person's spouse, they must have been married to each other for at least 5 consecutive years. In addition, the taxpayer must have a net income of not more than \$46,500 or, if married, a combined net income of less than \$59,400 and own net assets not in excess of \$222,500 excluding the value of the person's residence. The Select Board recommends this article. Majority vote required.	YES C
To see if the town will vote to authorize the Select Board, as provided by RSA 674:5, 1) to remove the Planning Board's responsibility for the town capital improvement program and 2) to establish, appoint and implement a Capital Improvement Program Committee whose purpose shall be to prepare and amend a recommended program of municipal capital improvement projects projected over a period of at least 6 years to assist the Select Board and the Advisory Budget Committee in completion of the annual budget. Membership of such committee shall include at least one member of the Planning Board and may include but not be limited to other members of the Planning Board, the Advisory Budget Committee, the Select Board, Town employees, and residents of the Town of Lee. The Select Board recommends this article. Majority vote required.	YES C
