Directions to parking areas and trailheads:

Recycling Center Road

- Location: off Rt. 155 (Mast Rd.), north of Mast Way School
- **Parking:** on the south side of Recycling Center Road, past the ballfield, before entering the Transfer Station/Recycling Center
- **Trailheads:** at the south end of the parking lot and directly across Recycling Center Road (north access)
- Access to The Roundabout and Crosswalk trails

Lee Library

- Location: 9 Mast Rd. (Rt. 155)
- **Parking:** next to Library
- Trailhead: starts behind the Library
- Access to the Bog Trail

Public Safety Complex

- Location: 20 George Bennett Rd
- Parking: east of the Safety Complex building, at sports field
- Trailhead: on the northwest corner of the playing field
- Access to The Roundabout via a connector trail.

Rita Lane

- Location: off Clement Way, which is off Rt. 125
- **Parking:** at the end of Rita Lane at the Wheelwright Pond parking area
- **Trailhead:** on the sharp corner of Rita Lane, .2 miles from gate, .5 mile from the parking area
- **NOTE:** Rita Lane is gated by the Town of Lee and closed in the winter and at the discretion of the Town
- Access to Wheelwright Pond Trail

Trails

The Roundabout

Starts: at the Recycling Center Road parking lot, from the Connector Trail at the Public Safety Complex, and from the Wheelwright Pond Trail

NOTE: The Roundabout forms the perimeter of the Town Forest trail system **Mileage:** 2.2 mile loop

Blazed: Yellow

Special Features: vernal pools, glacial erratic, seasonal streams, stone walls



The Crosswalk Starts: at the Recycling Center Road parking area, access from the south trailhead NOTE: The Crosswalk bisects The Roundabout Mileage: 1 mile Blazed: White Special Features: seasonal streams, stone walls, bench, pond

Bog Trail

Starts: behind the Lee Town Library. Mileage: .3 miles (meets The Roundabout) Blazed: Red Special Features: Colonial era cemetery, low bush blueberries, bench, bog platform

Wheelwright Pond Trail

Starts: on Rita Lane. Mileage: .2 miles (meets The Roundabout) Blazed: Blue Special Features: stone wall, seasonal stream

Orange Connector Trails (total of four)

- 1. Connects The Crosswalk to The Roundabout, .14 mile from Recycling Center Road trailhead, going clockwise
- 2. Connects The Roundabout to The Crosswalk, at northern end of trail system, .9 mile from Recycling Center Road trailhead, going clockwise
- 3. Connects Safety Complex Parking to Roundabout, .35 mile from Recycling Center Road trailhead, going clockwise
- 4. Connects Bog Trail to Roundabout, bypassing the Bog, .25 mile from Recycling Center Road trailhead, going clockwise

Permitted: walking, trail running, snowshoeing, cross country skiing, walking dogs on leash.

Dogs: Pick up dog waste, on and off the trail. Bags are provided at the Recycling Center Road, Library, and Public Safety Complex trailheads. Please dispose of used bags in designated dog waste cans.

Prohibited: 4-wheeling, snowmobiling, picking or digging up plants of any type, disturbing the wildlife, unauthorized trail construction.
