Emerson Farm: Laurel shared photos of the Emerson Farmhouse, which they recently purchased and which adjoins their land.

Minutes: Minutes of August 15, 2019 were approved as written.

NH Preservation Alliance: The Heritage Commission dues to the Preservation Alliance are due and we voted to pay them.

Barn Signs: The new barn sign for the Munger-Nooney property was presented to the owners recently. On Sunday, Sept. 22nd, the Jennison's will receive their sign. Signs for the Griswold Barn, as well as the Randall Barn will be arriving soon. Scott made a motion to spend \$80 to purchase these two signs, as well as another \$40 for the Blomquist-McCafferty barn which will say "R.C. Durgin Barn, ca 1750." Motion passed for a total of 3 new signs.

Lee Fair: The Heritage Commission sold six t-shirts, 2 large totes, a semiquincentennial coin, as well as mugs and various books, for total receipts of \$456.00

Treasurers Report: The Heritage Commission will make no request from the Budget Committee.

Mills Book (Scott Mills): At the fair, Laura had an opportunity to speak to Ramona (Scott Mills' sister) about the use of photos and stories in the book. Ramona will speak to "Aunt Joyce" who did much of the work in putting the book together.

Parish House: An application has been sent to the NH Historic Register, thanks to Scott and Laurel and any others who worked on this document. Motion made and approved to reimburse Scott \$30 for printing, postage and copying expenses.

TCVC (Town Center Vision Committee): There is an LCHIP grant workshop coming up in the near future. The TCVC will be looking for a grant for the Town Hall. Now they are looking for the best site for the Municipal Office Bldg. Assessors will look at the Town Hall.

Interviews: We have tentatively scheduled Meda Durepo's interview for November 10th. However, we won't check with her on the date until after her grandson's wedding in October.

Archival furnishings: These will be arriving tomorrow, September 20th. Scott has been making arrangements for the 500# pallet to be unloaded.
