Well & Water Awareness. Leslie redrafted document, Paul contributed new material from Lee Master Plan. Committee clarified privacy language. Discussed section about Lee wells serving Durham/UNH. Suggested edits; Leslie will redraft. Dean will contribute material about water testing & bottled water from NH DES. Plan to invite Lee Conservation Committee perhaps others into effort as soon as draft is deemed presentable.
